The Lummi Nation has received notice of the proposed Westcott Shores Joint-Use Dock Project on San Juan Island and is responding as an affected tribe. The Lummi Nation Tribal Historic Preservation Office (LNTHPO) has reviewed the distributed project documents as well as records on file at our office.

Based on this review, the LNTHPO recommends that an archaeological assessment be conducted prior to the development. The proposed development is within 500 feet of a previously recorded archaeological site.
