Inspection Required: Visual Inspection by a San Juan County Inspector of drilled holes for location, size, depth, and cleanliness is required prior to installation. Epoxy product and epoxy items are required to be on site for verification by inspector during this inspection.

Installation Certification: I hereby certify that I have reviewed and understand the designers' and the epoxy systems' specifications and installation requirements. I further attest that I have personally installed or supervised the installation of the epoxy items and that the holes have been drilled to the required diameter and depth; have been properly cleaned and prepared; and that the specified epoxy system and epoxy items have been utilized and have been properly installed in accordance with all required specifications and installation requirements. Generic Epoxy item installation procedure:

8. Verify Epoxy System to be utilized is that which the designer has specified.
9. Verify the Epoxy Item(s) is/are that which is specified by the designer.
10. Verify the hole diameter(s) is/are as specified by the Epoxy System for the item to be installed.
11. Verify the depth of the hole(s) is/are equal to or greater than that specified by the designer.
12. Verify holes have been prepared by following procedure:
 - a. Blowing out all dust and debris, and
 - b. Wire brushing the hole(s), and
 - c. Repeating the blowing out of all dust and debris.
13. Fill the hole(s) ½ full with the specified epoxy and applicator system from the bottom up.
14. Slowly push in while turning the epoxy item in a counter clockwise direction to the required depth.
