ORDER ON MOTION TO REDUCE
OR WAIVE LEGAL FINANCIAL
OBLIGATIONS (LFOs)

I. FINDINGS

The Court makes the following findings by a preponderance of the evidence:

- The San Juan County Prosecutor has waived notice of motions to waive/reduce LFOs.
- Defendant is indigent as defined by RCW 10.01.010(3)(a)-(c) because:

Defendant's household income is above 125% of the federal poverty guidelines/FPG but Defendant has recurring basic living expenses rendering Defendant unable to pay the LFOs imposed and payment would cause a manifest hardship on Defendant or Defendant's family.

- Defendant is not indigent and has the ability to pay some or all of the LFOs.
- Defendant is not in willful default.
- Defendant has paid all restitution principal owing.

II. CONCLUSIONS

The Court is required to waive non-restitution LFO interest accrued prior to June 7, 2018, and may waive interest on restitution where the principal has been paid. RCW 10.82.090(2)(b).

The Court is required to waive, reduce, or convert to community service all discretionary fines because the Defendant is not in willful contempt and is indigent as defined by RCW 10.01.010(3)(a)-(c).

Although Defendant's household income is above 125% of the federal poverty guidelines, the Court is required to waive, reduce, or convert to community service all discretionary LFOs because the Defendant is not in willful contempt and has recurring basic living expenses rendering Defendant without ability to pay the LFOs and payment of the amount due would impose manifest hardship on Defendant or Defendant's family. RCW 10.01.160(4).
