Lopez Farmers Market Bioswale

San Juan County Environmental Resources Division is protecting the environment by improving storm water management in Lopez Village. The Lopez Farmers Market Bioswale Project along 1.5 blocks of Village Rd will remedy parking needs and provide gravel road shoulders for pedestrian access. The existing roadside ditch will be upgraded to a vegetated treatment swale while improving stormwater conveyance.

What will result?

This project will result in:

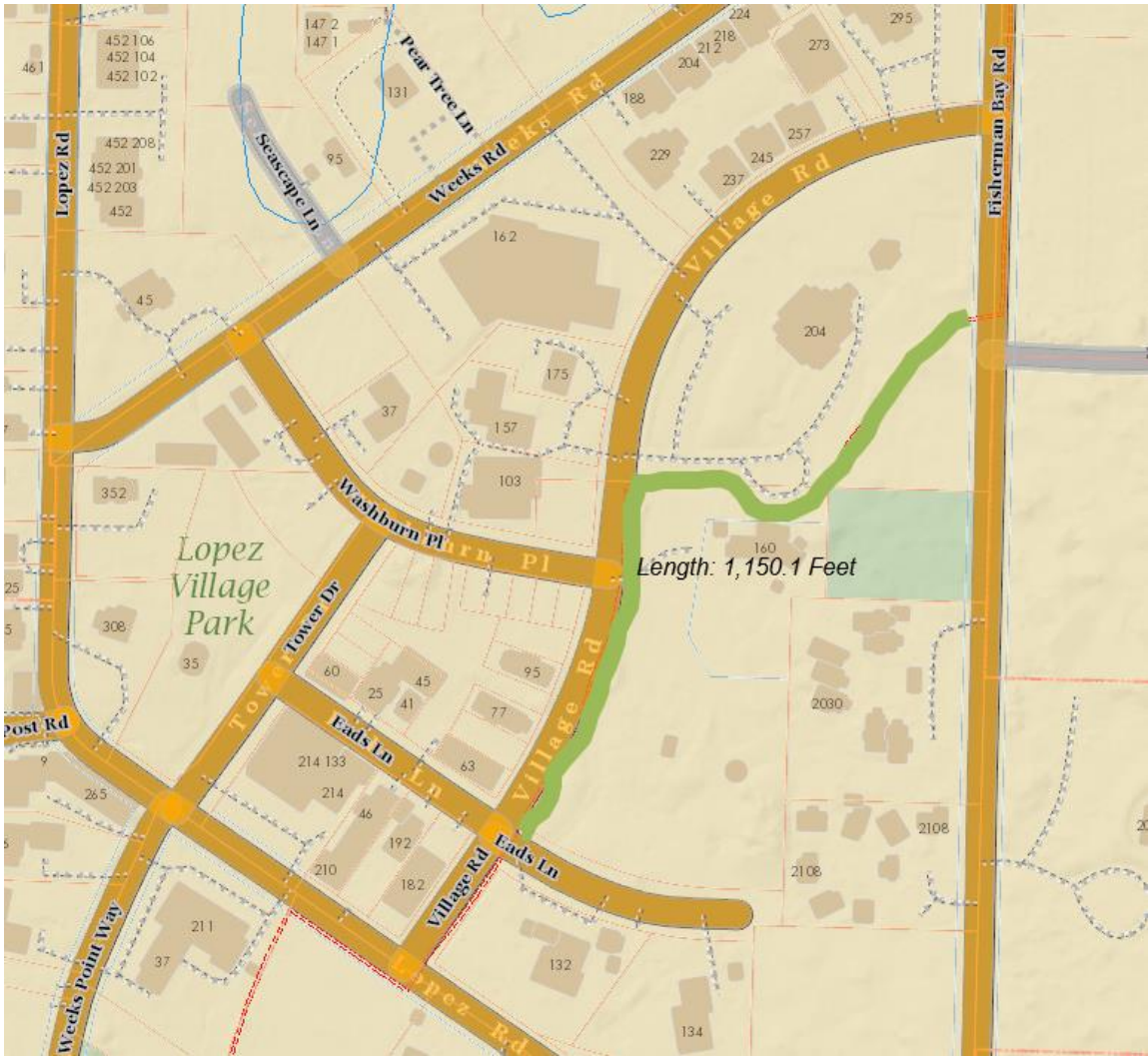
- Improved parking surface and upgraded pedestrian trail along Village Rd
- A constructed vegetated swale planted with native plants used for stormwater treatment
- Habitat for birds and butterflies
- Cleaner road runoff to help protect Fisherman Bay
- Management of stormwater conveyance
- An upgraded Farmers Market entryway and access bridges.

When will the project begin?

The project was scheduled to begin in July 2021, however the bid cost of the project exceeded the available budget. The County is reviewing the project for additional cost savings and alternative funding options. It is anticipated that the project will be re-bid in the late winter of 2021 for an April-May 2022 construction.

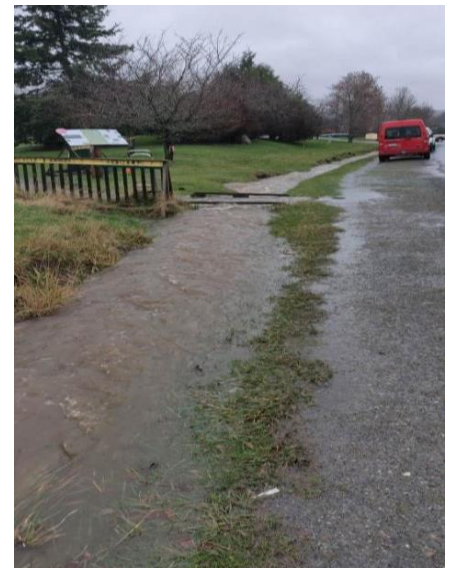




Project Area
