# Comment on proposed land use designation change from RR to RI

As stewards of this public property I do not feel that expanding the designation for possible use as equipment storage or material stockpiling is the best use of what is one of the most desirable beaches open to the public on San Juan.

I recognize that the ability to barge in gravel has been determined to be an essential service although I question whether it is a service that warrants the public works using this property for that purpose. My question would be whether a private entity could provide this at less impact and cost?

I am in favor of having this discussion in order to determine the master plan for this valuable community asset but am against the proposed possible uses being suggested. There surely is a more appropriate placement for equipment storage on the island than this waterfront.

Lastly, given the level of protection that any private development application goes thru on waterfront it seems that this is not being held to the same standards. Changing to this designation gives a very broad use as defined by "Essential Public Facility" and none of these are in the spirit of best use of this site .
