RESOLUTION 2021-1

A RESOLUTION BY THE ORCAS ISLAND PARK AND RECREATION DISTRICT TO AUTHORIZE THE SAN JUAN COUNTY AUDITOR TO PLACE BEFORE THE VOTERS A PROPOSITION FOR THE RENEWAL OF A REGULAR PROPERTY TAX LEVY.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners for Orcas Island Park and Recreation District (OIPRD) desire to fund the District so that the District may fulfill its duties to provide programs and recreational services for Orcas Island citizens as set forth in RCW 36.69.130; and

WHEREAS, voters in 2016 approved funding for proposed OIPRD programs, services and the maintenance and operation of Buck Park; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners desire to continue to operate, staff, provide programming and maintain Buck Park including improvements to the fields, courts, fences, irrigation, skatepark, playscape and parking lot at Buck Park; and

WHEREAS, OIPRD desires for voters to approve a renewal property tax levy to fund OIPRD authorized by RCW 36.69.145.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners for the Orcas Island Park and Recreation District:

The Board of Commissioners authorizes and requests that the San Juan County Auditor place before the voters during the November 2, 2021 general election a proposition requesting approval of renewed funding for the Orcas Island Park and Recreation District in the amount of 15 (fifteen) cents per \$1000.00 (one thousand dollars) of assessed value of property in each year for six consecutive years following voter approval, pursuant to RCW 36.69.145.


The Commissioners approve the following language for the ballot title, subject to review and approval by San Juan County Auditor and the Prosecuting Attorney:

WILL ORCAS ISLAND PARK AND RECREATION DISTRICT BE AUTHORIZED TO IMPOSE A RENEWAL OF REGULAR PROPERTY TAX LEVIES OF FIFTEEN CENTS PER THOUSAND DOLLARS OF ASSESSED VALUATION FOR EACH YEAR FOR SIX CONSECUTIVE YEARS?

ADOPTED this 8th day of July 2021.






