DCD recently updated the VRP data posted on the GIS Open Data / Land Use web site; the data is much much cleaner than the PRR data sent in early July 2021

No field definitions are supplied by DCD. However, by inspection, the column (field) "status" now only has 3 entries:

blank
active
inactive

by inspection the F2020 field appears to have the compliance permit number issued by DCD for year 2020
note: 385 of 996 entries in this field are blank, which should be interpreted as non-compliant, since no permit number was issued.
